Los Angeles, CA (November 7, 2025)—Discos Musart completes its vibrant tribute to the legendary Mexican singer-songwriter **Joan Sebastian** with ***Secreto de amor (Las noches)***—a 5-track digital EP of remixes crafted by genre-blending DJ, producer and multi-instrumentalist **Sinego**. Commemorating the **10th anniversary** of Sebastian’s passing, this electrifying collection reimagines four of Joan’s most beloved classics—“**Secreto de amor**,” “**Sentimental**,” “**Un Idiota**” and “**Más allá del sol**”—through a bold, contemporary lens. **Now available to stream or download** in standard and hi-res digital formats, these first-ever official dance remixes transform timeless Regional Mexican ballads into hypnotic, club-ready anthems. The EP includes three previously released singles and introduces two new tracks: the extended remix “**Más allá del sol (La luna)**” and the standard remix “**Más allá del sol (Eclipse)**.”

Beloved for his heartfelt ballads and soul-stirring performances, Joan Sebastian captured the essence of love, loss and life with unmatched sincerity. A decade after his passing, his timeless songs continue to resonate with fans across the globe. With this project, Discos Musart fondly pays tribute to Joan’s enduring legacy and the magic he infused into every lyric and melody. These final remixes of “Más allá del sol” offer a captivating fusion of Joan’s emotional balladry with modern house rhythms—anchored by steady, hypnotic percussion, that rises beneath his hauntingly romantic vocals.

“‘Más allá del sol’ has one of my favorite lyrics in all of Mexican music. *Más allá del sol y más allá de todos mis errores / Que no les quede duda que tú eres el más grande de todos mis amores* (Beyond the sun and beyond all of my mistakes / Let there be no doubt that you are the greatest of all my loves). That phrase really transcends all music genres and takes Joan Sebastian’s music to a poetry realm. Thus, I decided to finish my EP for Musart with this track. I have been playing the track in Miami, Ibiza, London and more this past year, and I love how people that don’t know the language can connect with Joan’s music,” recalls Sinego.

The original song “Más allá del sol” (Beyond the Sun) is the title track to Joan’s studio album released by Discos Musart on April 24, 2006. The song—written by Joan Sebastian—peaked at No.3 on the *Billboard* Hot Latin Songs chart and was his longest-running song on the chart, remaining on it for 35 weeks. The album, produced by Joan, was a massive hit, earning GRAMMY® and Latin GRAMMY awards, both in the Best Banda Album category, and reaching the No.2 position on the *Billboard* Regional Mexican Albums chart.

About Joan Sebastian:

Known as “El Rey del Jaripeo” (The King of Mexican Rodeo) and “El Poeta del Pueblo” (The People’s Poet), **Joan Sebastian** (April 8, 1951 – July 13, 2015) was one of Mexico’s most successful and prolific artists, who penned over 1,000 songs during his four-decade career. Born José Manuel Figueroa in the village of Juliantla, Guerrero, Mexico, the singer, songwriter, and actor released his debut LP in 1975 via **Discos Musart**, the prestigious Mexican label under which Sebastian would release nearly three dozen albums and seven Top Ten hits on *Billboard*’s Hot Latin Songs chart (including “Secreto de amor”). Joan remains one of Mexico’s most celebrated musicians, who not only sold millions of his own records worldwide, but also wrote hits for stars like Pepe Aguilar, Lucero, Vicente Fernández, and Rocío Dúrcal, among many others. During his life, the decorated artist received a variety of honors, including four GRAMMY® Awards, seven Latin GRAMMYs (he is the most awarded Mexican performer in GRAMMY history), an incredible 43 ASCAP Awards, and four *Billboard* Latin Music Awards. During his successful career, he landed on the *Billboard* Hot Latin Songs chart 42 times. In 2006, Sebastian was inducted into *Billboard* Latin Music Hall of Fame. While Sebastian’s work spanned pop, soft rock, and country, the versatile artist was best known for his regional Mexican hits, including banda, mariachi, and norteño styles.

About Sinego:

Named by GRAMMY.com as one of “7 Latin DJs to Watch” in 2023 and selected by Beatport to be among their “Next” artists for 2024, Sinego is quickly becoming a global sensation. In addition to producing official remixes for the likes of Sofi Tukker, Bomba Estéreo, Elsa y Elmar, and Matanza (Rodrigo Gallardo), Sinego has performed on high-profile stages across the world, including EDC Mexico, and Lightning in a Bottle festival, as well as Ibiza’s Playa Soleil and Dolce & Gabbana’s Marbella club. Profiled in *The Fader* and *Popdust*, Sinego also curates the popular Spotify playlist “Track IDs,” and hosts Apple Music’s official Viajero mix series, in which he collaborates with influential Latin American artists. Last year, Sinego released his debut album, *Alterego*, in which he blends an array of regional Latin music with modern dance aesthetics.
